A Multi-Volume Collection of Photographs of Israel and Her Neighbors

The Pictorial Library of Bible Lands is a collection of more than 6,000 high-quality photographs of important biblical and ancient sites throughout the Middle East. All images are high-resolution (1600 x 1200 pixels or higher) jpeg files, which means that the photos look crisp and clear for projecting in an auditorium, viewing on a monitor or printing. All of the photos are also included in pre-made annotated PowerPoint files, for easy access and use by pastors, teachers and students.
